Study Sample and Design Summary Participants: Six districts, 90 schools, and 270 second grade teachers participated in the study during the year that the PD interventions were implemented. During the follow-up year ( which included only data collection ), the number of teachers participating was 250 in the fall and 254 in the spring. Participating districts used one of two commonly used scientifically based reading programs. Schools selected for the study were high-poverty urban or urban fringe public elementary schools in which fewer than half the students were designated as English language learners ( ELL ). Schools were screened out if they were already receiving Reading First funding ( and therefore might already be participating in intensive PD ) or if they planned to receive this funding during the first year of the study. Research Design: Within each district, schools were randomly assigned in equal numbers to treatment A, treatment B, or the control..



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
